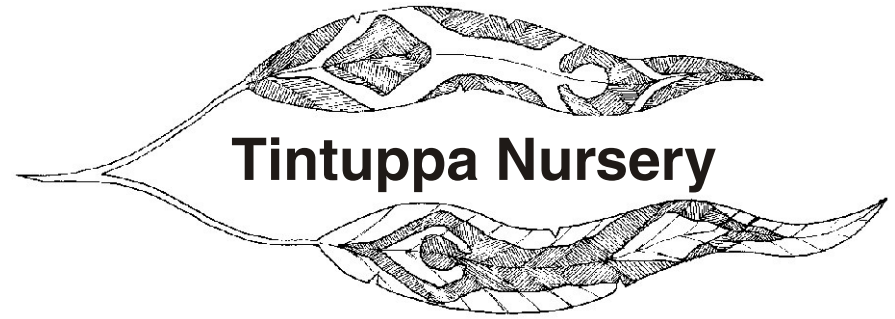

Acacia acuminata Raspberry Jam Wattle	☒ Large shrub to 5m, golden rod flowers in spring. Drought and frost resistant and salt soil tolerant. Fragrant timber.
Acacia baileyana Cootamundra Wattle	Small tree to 6m, silver-grey feathery leaves. Spectacular flowers July & August. Most soils. Hardy. Tolerant of frost, dryness and protected coastal area.
Acacia baileyana "Purpurea"	Cootamundra Wattle – purple leaf form
Acacia cyclops	☒ Tall spreading shrub, coastal planting. Tolerates some wetness, dryness, lime and salt soil
Acacia extensa Wiry Wattle	☒ Small erect leafless shrub. Balls of yellow flowers winter, spring. Well drained soils. Tolerates some wetness and dryness. Usually frost resistant.
Acacia fimbriata Fringed Wattle	Small tree with attractive weeping foliage. Profuse perfumed ball flowers in July-October. Hardy. Tolerates dryness, lime, frost and some wetness. Good dense screen plant.
Acacia glaucoptera Clay Wattle	☒ Small dense attractive shrub to 1.5m x 2.5m. Red new growth. Useful ground cover for open aspect. Ball flowers along stems in late winter
Acacia howittii Sticky Wattle	Pendulous dense large shrub to 6m, shiny light-green foliage, masses of lemon-yellow flowers in spring. Well-drained soils. Tolerates salt, frost and lime.
Acacia iteaphylla Flinders Ranges Wattle	Large weeping shrub to 5m, blue-green foliage, perfumed yellow flowers. Well-drained soils. Tolerates salt, drought, frost and lime.

Acacia lasiocalyx	✘	Tall shrub, small tree, long thin foliage, attractive white trunk. Well drained soils. Coastal
Acacia lasiocarpa	✘	Small shrub ideal for rockery or pots. Well drained soils. Tolerates dryness, lime and coastal situation.
Acacia littorea	✘	Dense 1-3m shrub. Flowers August to November. Useful sand binding plant for coastal areas.
Acacia melanoxylon Blackwood Wattle		Graceful upright tree to 30m with dense foliage. Clusters of creamy flower-balls winter/spring. Best in rich soils. Shade, erosion control, long-lived valuable timber tree.
Acacia myrtifolia Myrtle Wattle	✘	Compact, rounded shrub 1 to 2.5m. Light yellow flowers in spring. Most soils. Hardy. Tolerates dryness, lime and smog. Frost resistant.
Acacia pendula Weeping Myall		Small tree to 12m with silvery-blue-green weeping foliage, lemon-yellow flowers in winter. Medium to heavy well drained soils. Tolerates salt and lime soils. Good windbreak, fodder and firewood.
Acacia podalyriifolia Queensland Silver Wattle		Dense tall shrub to 5m, rounded silvery grey foliage. Dense flowers in mid winter. Any well drained soils. Fast growing, bird attracting.
Acacia pulchella Prickly Moses	✘	Small rounded shrub to 1m. Flowers in winter. Jarrah understorey. Tolerates dryness, lime and frost.
Acacia rostellifera	✘	Fast growing spreading small shrub. Good screen. Sandy soils, tolerates dryness, lime and coastal exposure and frost.
Acacia saligna Golden wreath wattle	✘	Large shrub or small tree. Large ball flowers in spring. Tolerates dryness, lime and salt soil. Resistant to salt spray.
Acacia spectabilis Mudgee Wattle		Fast growing upright shrub to 5m, slender with a weeping habit. Well-drained soils. Frost and drought resistant. Open screen or group planting.
Acacia vestita Hairy Wattle		Beautiful small weeping shrub to 4m. Heavy clusters of flowers in spring. Well-drained soils. Tolerates frost and dryness.
Acmena smithii Lilly Pilly		Medium sized bushy tree. White flowers in summer followed by pink edible fruit. Most soils. Frost resistant.
Agonis flexuosa Willow Peppermint	✘	Weeping dense small tree to 8m. Hardy plant, most soils. Tolerates lime, sandy soils and dry conditions once established.
Agonis juniperina Native Ceder	✘	Upright columnar shrub to 5m. Profuse white flowers most of the year. Good screen, very hardy and cut flower. Most soils.
Agonis linearifolia	✘	Medium shrub to 4m. White flowers in spring summer. Most soils, understorey, stream revegetation.

Carex appressa Tall Sedge	✘	Large ornamental tussock grass 80cm x 60cm. Attractive with large yellow seed heads in spring. Tolerant of very wet and dry conditions.
Carex flagellifera		Graceful, weeping ornamental. Forms clumps of fine curled bronze foliage to 60cm. Well drained moist soil in shade or part shade.
Carex morrowii Variegated Japanese Sedge		Hardy clump forming sedge 30cm x 45cm. Rich green leaves with white stripes. Very adoptable but prefers moist conditions. Full sun or part shade. Frost tolerant. Rockeries and boggy sites.
Carex tereticaulis	✘	Large clumping grass, permanently and seasonally wet areas. Tall brown flowering spikes. Used in basket making.
Cymbopogon ambiguus	✘	Hardy tufted perennial that forms erect slender tussocks to 1m. Attractive seed heads in summer. Will tolerate dry rocky areas.
Cymbopogon obtectus Native Lemon Grass		Aromatic lemony leaves to 30cm. Hardy, flower spike up to 80cm. Most conditions.
Festuca glauca Blue Fescue		Hardy, tufting grass to 15cm with blue green foliage. Borders, rockeries or group planting among low shrubs.
Isolepis cernua Fairy Lights		Tufted grass like plant to 30cm with weeping foliage. Tiny star like flowers most year. Shady but well lit, moist situation.
Isolepis nodosa Knotted clubrush		Ornamental tufted rush to 1m. Very hardy, damp areas, also binding in sandy soils.
Juncus pallidus Pale Rush	✘	Clumping rush for seasonally wet areas. Hardy grows 2m x2m. Flowers late spring summer.
Juncus subsecundus Finger Rush	✘	Clumping rush 1m x 0.5m. Wet areas, bogs, ponds river banks.
Juncus kraussii Sea Rush	✘	Clumping rush 1m x 1m. Suitable for fringing, rivers and Wetlands .
Lomandra longifolia Spinney headed Matt Brush		Graceful, ornamental large tussock grass like plant 1x1m. Creamy spikes of fragrant flowers in spring. Most soils including moist. Frost resistant.
Poa labillardieri Large Tussock Grass		Large hardy perennial attractive grass to 80 X 80cm. Grey green leaves. Tolerates most conditions including wet areas. Borders, pond gardens.
Poa porphyroclados	✘	Large densely tufted perennial to 0.9m. Will tolerate dry conditions, hardy.

Melaleuca raphiophylla Swamp Paperbark	✘ Large shrub to medium sized tree. For waterlogged coastal areas. Papery trunk. Cream flowers in spring.
Melaleuca scabra Rough Honey Myrtle	✘ Low growing shrub to 1m. Masses of bright deep pink terminal flowers with gold tips in spring. Well-drained soil in a sunny open position. Tolerates frost.
Melaleuca spathulata	✘ Small shrub to 1.5m. Deep pink heads of flowers in spring. Well-drained soils. Tolerates wetness and dryness. Frost resistant.
Melaleuca styphelloides Prickly Paperbark	Small to medium tree with beautiful white to tan papery bark. Large number of cream flowers in late spring-summer. Any soil. Most conditions. Tolerates dryness and frost.
Melaleuca thymifolia Thyme Honey Myrtle	✘ Fast growing, spreading compact shrub to 1m. Deep mauve fringed flowers along stem in spring and summer. Most soils. Moist conditions, dryness and frost tolerant.
Melaleuca violacea	✘ Small shrub or groundcover with small attractive leaves and violet flowers in spring. Most soils. Tolerates wetness, dryness, lime and frost.
Mirbelia dilatata	✘ Shrub 2-3m with prickly foliage and blue-purple pea flowers in late spring. Hardy in well-drained soil. Frost resistant.
Paraserianthes lophantha Albizia	✘ Small tree up to 8m with soft fern-like foliage and scented small bottlebrush flowers in autumn through spring. Most soils. Tolerates wetness. Fast growing shade or screen for new garden.
Pultenaea villosa	✘ Pendulous small spreading shrub 1 x 2m. Yellow pea flowers in spring. Hardy plant. Well-drained soil.
Templetonia retusa Cocky's Tongue	✘ Rounded spreading shrub to 2m. Abundant scarlet pink flowers in winter. Sunny well drained soil. Exposed coastal gardens. Lime tolerant and frost hardy.
Viminaria juncea Swish Bush	✘ Ornamental small tree like shrub. Slender leafless branches and weeping habit. Yellow pea flowers along branches spring\early summer. Moist soils. Frost resistant.

Agonis parviceps	✘ Medium to tall shrub 3-6m, white flowers in spring. Most soils. Tolerates wet conditions and frost. Cut flower.
Allocasuarina fraseriana W.A. Sheoak	✘ Large tree with dark green foliage. Well drained soils, sand. Tolerates dryness, lime and frost.
Allocasuarina huegeliana Granite Sheoak	✘ Tree 4 to 10m. Dark fissured bark. Tolerates dryness, lime and granite.
Allocasuarina humilis Dwarf Sheoak	✘ Small shrub to 1.5m. Well drained soils. Tolerates sandy soils, dryness lime and frost.
Allocasuarina verticulata Coastal Drooping Sheoak	Rounded tree to 10m. Attractive drooping dark green foliage. Ornamental, windbreak. Tolerates salt and lime.
Alyogyne huegelii Lilac Hibiscus	✘ Fast growing rounded shrub to 2m. Soft foliage. Attractive single lilac flowers in spring and summer. Hardy. Most soils. Frost tolerant.
Anigozanthos flavidus Red Kangaroo Paw	✘ Tall spikes of rusty red flowers in spring and summer. Vigorous clumping plant. 1mx1m. Most soils. Attracts nectar birds.
Anigozanthos flavidus Yellow Kangaroo Paw	✘ Yellow greenish flowers on tall, branched flower spikes in spring and summer. Vigorous clumping plant. 1mx1m. Most soils. Attracts nectar birds.
Astartea fascicularis	✘ Small spreading shrub 1 X 1.5m across. White or pink tea tree like flowers throughout the year. Most soils. Frost tolerant, hardy reliable plant.
Banksia species	Limited number of some species available. Please inquire.
Beaufortia sparsa Swamp Bottlebrush	✘ Erect shrub to 3m, dark green foliage crowded along branches, striking scarlet brush flowers late summer and autumn. Well-drained soils. Tolerates frost. Good cut flower.
Billardiera ringens	✘ Creeper or climbing plant with dense clusters of orange flowers turning red with age in spring and summer. Well drained soil. Tolerates lime and light frost.
Bossiaea linophylla WA Sun Bush	✘ Small shrub to 2m. Yellow and red pea flowers in spring. Hardy fast growing. Reasonable drainage. Good small screen.
Callistachys lanceolata	✘ Erect shrub or tree usually 2 to 7m. Orange yellow pea flowers Sept to Jan. Sandy soils, damp areas, along water courses and swamps.
Callistemon citrinus Crimson Bottlebrush	Large shrub or small tree 4m, dense foliage, massed with crimson flowers in spring/summer. All soils. Tolerates salt soils, lime, water logging and pollution.
Callistemon phenecious	✘ Shrub to 2 x 1.5m with grey-green leaves and brilliant red flower spikes 12cm long in late spring to early summer. Most soils. Hardy. Tolerates damp conditions.

Hardy, will grow in most soils and conditions from very wet to very dry. Moderate frosts.	Melaleuca huegelii Chenille Honey Myrtle	✘ Evergreen medium shrub, good screening plant. Profuse spikes of creamy flowers in summer. Well drained soils, in full sun, resistant to salt spray and tolerates lime.
Calothamnus quadrifidus Blood-Red Net Bush	✘ Tall spreading shrub to 2.5m, silky pine like needles, deep red claw flowers late spring through to the following winter. Light well drained soils. Numerous pastel yellow brush flowers in spring. Bird attracting hardy species.

Dodonaea viscosa Hop Bush	✘ Fast growing, hardy medium to tall ornamental shrub. Large hop like fruit turning deep red. Well-drained position. Tolerates wind, some coastal exposure and frosts. Tolerates coastal exposure, drought, salt, lime and smog.

Eucalyptus kruseana Book Leaf Mallee	✘ Medium to tall ornamental shrub. Blue grey foliage used in floral arrangements. Tolerates drought and lime.
Eucalyptus laeliae Darling River Ghost Gum	✘ Medium sized tree with white bark. Good shade tree, masses of cream flowers in summer. Well drained soils. Tolerates drought and light frosts.
Eucalyptus lehmannii Bushy Yate	✘ Dense rounded mallee to 6m. Large clusters of green flowers winter and spring followed by large spiky fruit. Most well drained soils. Tolerates salt and drought, fire retardant.
Eucalyptus leucoxydon Rosea	Small to medium tree to 15m. White, pink or red flowers from autumn to summer. Most soils. Tolerates salt, lime, drought and frost.
Eucalyptus maginata Jarrah	✘ Medium to tall tree. Persistent fibrous bark and white flowers. Well drained soils. Tolerates dryness and light frost.
Eucalyptus maculata Spotted Gum	Tall tree to 40m. Straight trunk with attractive brown spotted smooth bark. Most soils. Tolerates lime, salt and smog. Maybe frost tender when young.
Eucalyptus megacarpa Bullich	✘ Small to medium tree with smooth white bark and a dense crown. Tolerates swampy soils, dry areas and moderate frosts.
Eucalyptus nicholii Peppermint Gum	Medium tree 20m, with a weeping habit, narrow leaves. Most soils, but well drained. Hardy to frosts and will withstand dryness.
Eucalyptus patens Blackbutt	✘ Large tree to 25m. Prefers moist soils but not waterlogged. Tolerates frost.
Eucalyptus platypus Round-leaved Moort	✘ Tall shrub or small tree, bushy crown. Most soils. Tolerates salt soils, lime, light frosts, dryness and pollution.
Eucalyptus pressiana Bell Fruited Mallee	✘ Small tree to 4m. Smooth bark and thick oblong leaves to 11cm. Bright yellow flowers in spring. Excellent ornamental, prune to shape. Well-drained soils.
Eucalyptus pulverulenta Silver Dollar	Small tree to 8m. Young and adult leaves silvery grey. Good foliage contrast and for floral arrangements. Well-drained soil. Frost tolerant.
Eucalyptus pyriformis	✘ Small mallee, very large red or yellow flowers, pendulous habit. Bird attracting. Dry areas.
Eucalyptus robusta Swamp Mahogany	Medium tree to 15m with thick dark green leaves. Tolerates salt soils, severe coastal exposure, heavy sodden conditions and frost.
Eucalyptus rudis Flooded Gum	✘ Tall fast growing tree with white flowers in spring. Low lying moist areas. Soil and sand binder and water absorber. Tolerates light frost.
Eucalyptus salmonophloia Salmon Gum	✘ Large open tree to 25m with salmon coloured smooth bark. Well-drained soils. Tolerates drought, lime, salt, and light frost. Shelter, shade, timber and ornamental.

Eucalyptus salubris Gimlet	✘ Medium tree to 20m with light brownish smooth twisted trunk and shiny green leaves. White flowers. Well-drained soils. Tolerates lime, drought, salt, and light frost. Windbreak, shelter and ornamental.
Eucalyptus sargentii Sargent's Mallet	✘ Small to medium tree, spreading crown, greenish white flowers in spring. Tolerates salt soil, drought, lime, waterlogging. Fire retardant.
Eucalyptus sideroxydon Red Ironbark	Medium tree to 15m. Clusters of pink flowers in autumn. Hardy tree that will tolerate extended dry periods and frosts.
Eucalyptus spathulata Swamp Mallet	✘ Small tree with fine foliage and attractive trunk. Most soils. Tolerates lime, salt soils and waterlogging.
Eucalyptus torquata Coral Gum	✘ Small tree to 10m. Clusters of distinctive red buds with white to deep pink flowers in spring and summer. Light to medium soils. Tolerates salt soils, lime and drought. Frost tender when young.
Eucalyptus wandoo Wandoo	✘ Medium tree to 20m with long narrow leaves and smooth mottled bark. White flowers. Well-drained soil. Tolerates dryness, lime and light frost. Ornamental shade tree.
Eucalyptus woodwardii Lemon Flowered Gum	✘ Ornamental, medium sized tree with large showy yellow flowers in winter and spring. Sandy or heavy soils. Frost tolerant
Grevillea robusta Silky Oak	Tall straight tree to 30m with attractive fern like foliage. Spectacular golden orange toothbrush flowers in spring. Well-drained soil. Tolerates dryness and frost once established.
Guichenotia macrantha Purple Bells	✘ Dense rounded shrub to 1m with narrow grey-green leaves. Showy pink-purple bellflowers in winter and spring. Most soils including salty but needs good drainage.
Hakea bucculenta	✘ Tall shrub to 4m with fine long leaves. Tapered spikes of red flowers 15cm long in winter and spring. Outstanding ornamental. Good drainage essential.
Hakea corymbosa	✘ Tightly compact shrub to 2 x 2m with stiff narrow leaves and lime green flowers at the top of the shrub in late winter spring. Light well-drained soil in full sun. Tolerates dryness and frost. Bird attracting.
Hakea lasianthoides	✘ Erect shrub or tree 2 to 4m high. White cream flowers Sept to Nov. Sandy loam, sandy gravel, damp habitats to ridge tops.
Hakea laurina Pincushion Hakea	✘ Small tree or shrub to 6m. Wonderful large rounded crimson and cream ballflowers autumn and winter. Well-drained soils. Usually frost resistant.
Hakea lissocarpa Honey Bush	✘ Low small spreading shrub. Dense habit with prolific white to pink flowers in winter. Well-drained soil. Tolerates dryness and frost.
Hakea petiolaris Sea Urchin Hakea	✘ Tall shrub to 5m with attractive leaves. Purplish and cream pincushion flowers in autumn and winter. Most soils, good drainage. Tolerates
